



2025 US Section Training Program

We have been notified by the IPA International Executive Board that two sections in our organization have submitted appeals for emergency aid after significant flooding has impacted both countries. The section requesting emergency aid from International and other sections are Section Spain and Section Bosnia Herzegovina.

Here is what we have received from both the International Executive Board (IEB):

IPA Section Bosnia Herzegovina and Section Spain request for aid:

Dear friends, a few weeks ago our friends in Bosnia Herzegovina, and Spain had to endure some difficult hours as they experienced severe flooding. The strength of the water was evident, leaving many people homeless. Some IPA members and their families were also affected.

Although the full extent cannot yet be described, let's set an example and support our friends in both Bosnia Herzegovina and Spain with a financial contribution.

The IEB has decided to support these two sections and has therefore circulated this emergency aid appeal for financial support to all sections.

Anyone wishing to make a donation to either (or both) of these sections can send a check to our National Treasurer Tony Powers and we will after 3 weeks submit the first of these donations to the respective sections. Treasurer Powers would like you to indicate on the check memo line which section you are donating too. Please make all checks to specifically "INTERNATIONAL POLICE ASSOCIATION" - no abbreviated titles or section as this is what our bank requires and they will reject the check if submitted in any other way.


